DO NOT

- Endanger Anyone Including Yourself
- Bully, Harass or Hassle People Verbally, Physically, or Sexually (in person or remotely e.g. online)
- Violate Privacy
- Be Rude
- Touch Inappropriately

GUIDANCE

As a Scout you have a lot of freedom. Scouts is all about testing yourself and working out your boundaries as you grow as people. Do you have to be perfect? No. Is mucking around ok? Of course it is – not only is it ok, we expect and encourage it. Just remember there is such a thing as too much – when someone (Scout or Leader) asks you to stop – you must. We have serious times (e.g. parade) – respect them.

If a Scout deliberately makes you feel bad or hurts you speak up. The Adult Leaders don't see everything.

PUNISHMENT

The troop is governed by the Troop Council (Patrol Leaders and sometimes Assistant Patrol Leaders) alongside the Adult Leaders. If a complaint is made against a Scout (that means all of us) then it must be heard by the Troop Council. The Leaders will offer guidance to the Council. The Council will be reasonable in their decision. They may choose from the following punishments:

- Apology to the affected Scout(s)
- Exclude a member from Scouting temporarily or permanently
- Have the member do service.

If the Adult Leaders just behaviour to be so poor there is no other choice, the Scout(s) in question will be sent home. In some cases the Adult Leaders will discuss the issue with a parent or guardian of the Scout(s).
